This painting is *Jesus Tempted* by artist Chris Cook. It is obvious which is Jesus with the halo and which is the devil silhouetted as a dark

figure. There is something sinister and eerie about the Cook's painting. But evil and temptation are not always so easy to see. Dishonesty, half-truths, fake news, lies and deceit can so often appear an easy way out of uneasy situations. But right is right, wrong is wrong and truth is truth. Jesus saw through all the traps and the deceit of human nature and focussed on God's Word to discern what was right. 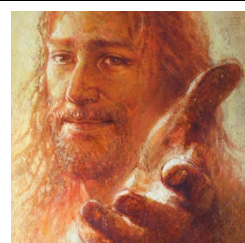
